



Notary Information Service



Information Needed vs Information Provided

- ▶ **Liability** of Notary under national law
- ▶ **NetPRO** provides access to information
- ▶ Administrative agent (*gestorio*) provides **actual** information

Service Contract (1/2)

- ▶ Law of notary as applicable law
- ▶ Court of notary with exclusive jurisdiction
- ▶ Legal liability remains
- ▶ Primary insurance with *gestorio*

Service Contract (2/2)

- ▶ Law of notary as applicable law
- ▶ Court of notary with exclusive jurisdiction
- ▶ Legal liability remains, obligation shift to *gestorio* for work carried out
- ▶ Primary insurance with *gestorio*, secondary cover from notary's insurance

Conclusion and Payment

- ▶ Standardised contract
- ▶ Approval from insurance company
- ▶ Payment electronically (retention of documents until payment)
