# The goal of the e-CODEX project



The goal of the e-CODEX project is to:

“Improve the cross-border access of citizens and businesses to legal means in Europe as well as to improve the interoperability between legal authorities within the EU.”

In a nutshell:

- **Easy and secure access to legal information and procedures** in other EU Member States for businesses and citizens
- Greater **effectiveness** and **improved efficiency** of cross-border judicial processes through **common standards** and **greater interoperability** of information systems

# The e-CODEX project aims at...

- **Contributing** to the implementation of the EU legal framework and the e-Justice action plan, in due respect of subsidiarity
- **Achieving** interoperability between existing national judicial systems
- **Enabling** all Member States to work together towards a more effective judicial system in Europe
- **Improving** the effectiveness and efficiency of the processing of the increasing number of cross border proceedings, especially in civil, criminal and commercial matters
- **Contributing** to a safer environment inside the EU for citizens
- **Modernizing** the judicial systems in Europe
- **Increasing** collaboration and exchange between judicial systems of the Member States



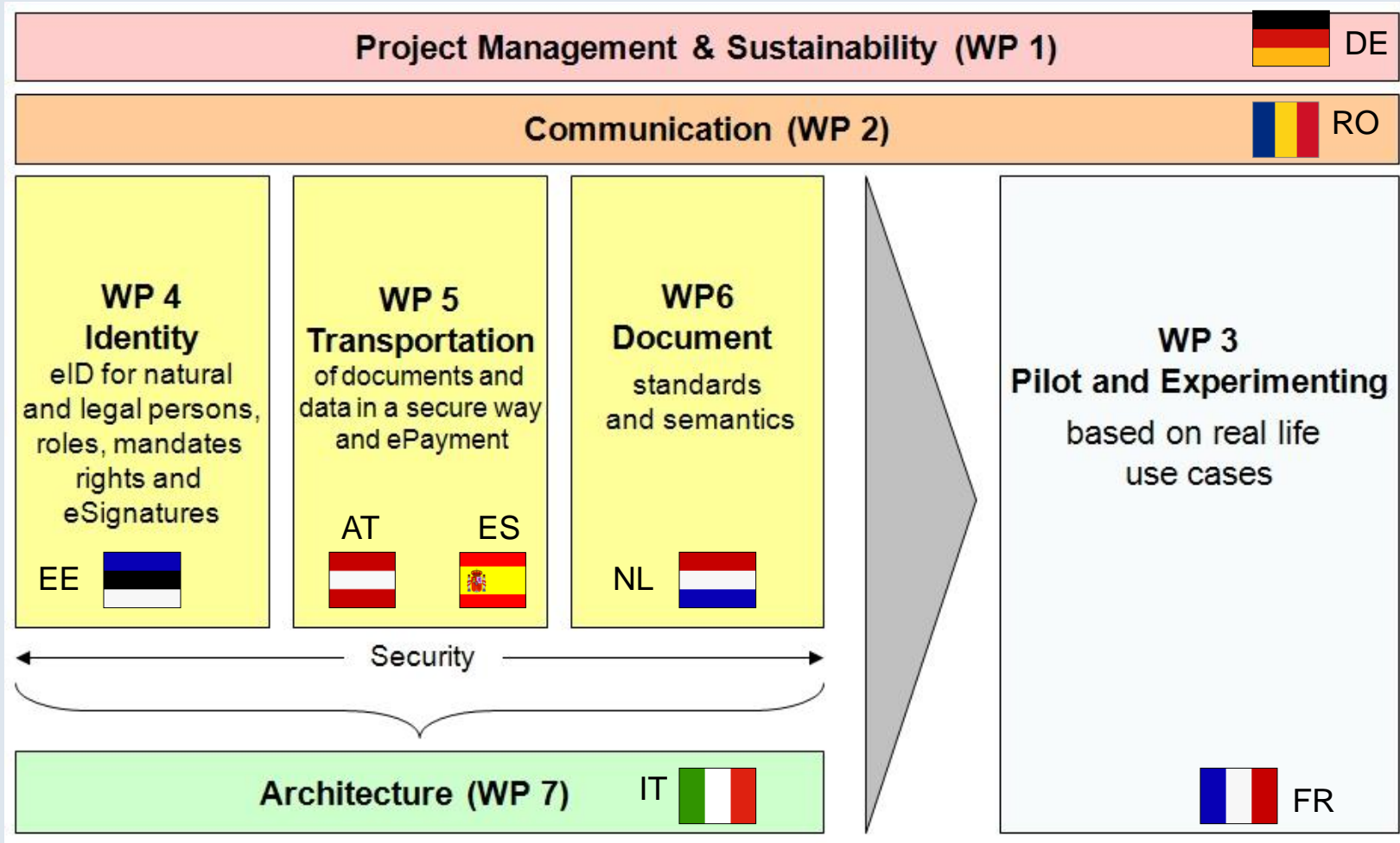

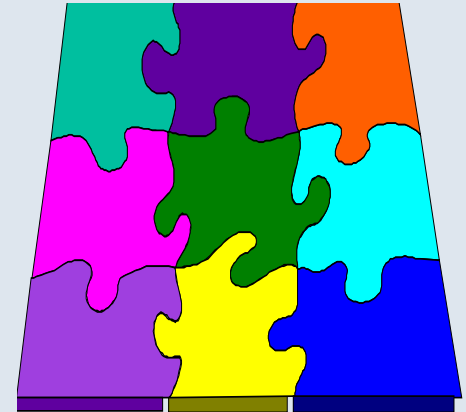
# The project is structured into 7 work packages

The objective of the pilot Work Package is to demonstrate the value of the solutions developed by testing them in a real life environment.

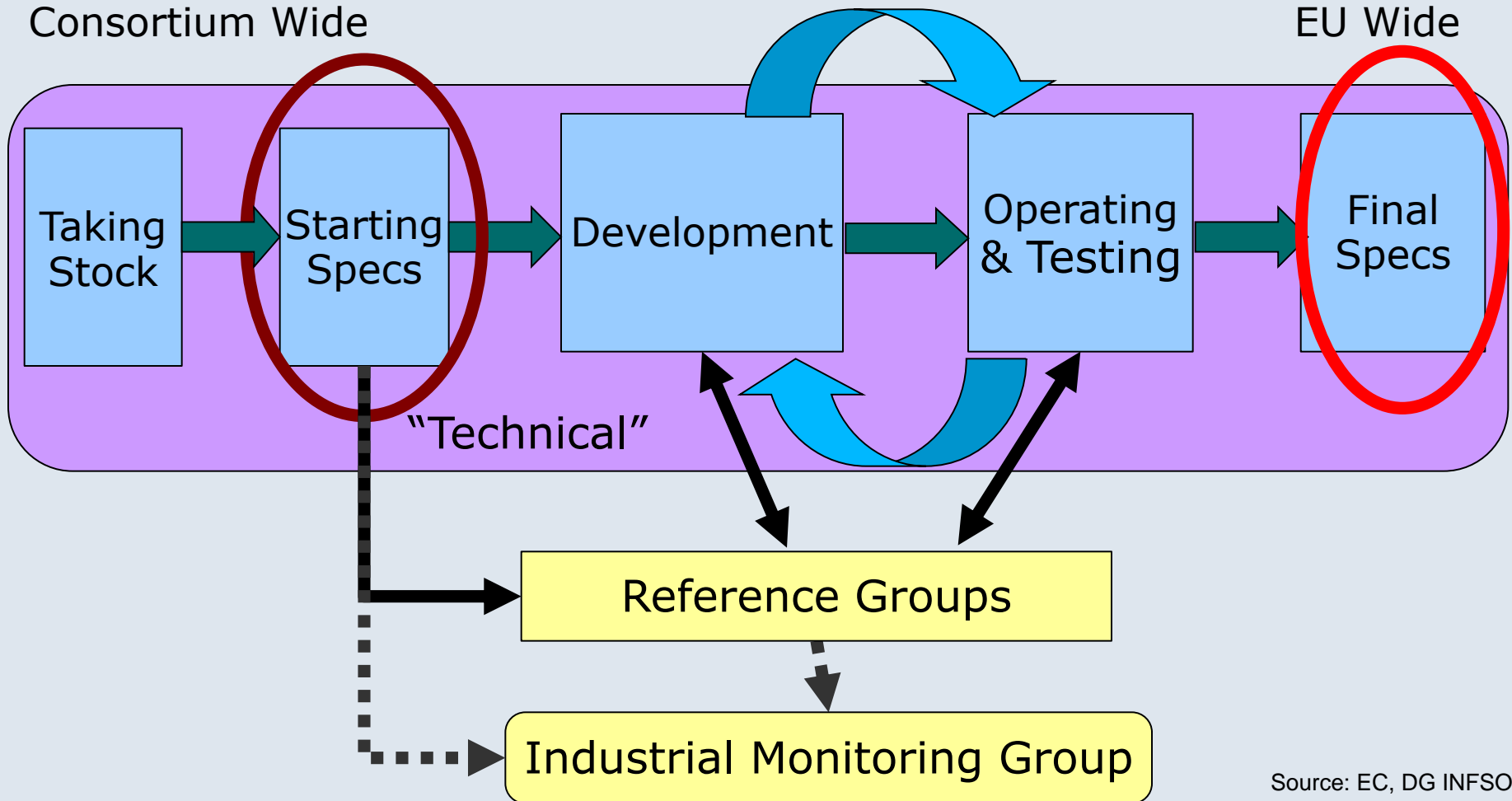
- The real life cases will be called **pilots**. These will offer **true use cases** to be tested during 12 months
- Among others, the following areas will be explored:
  - Cross border claim procedures (Civil Justice)
  - Mutual Court Assistance (Civil Justice and Criminal Justice)
  - Interconnection of registers (Civil Justice and Criminal Justice)

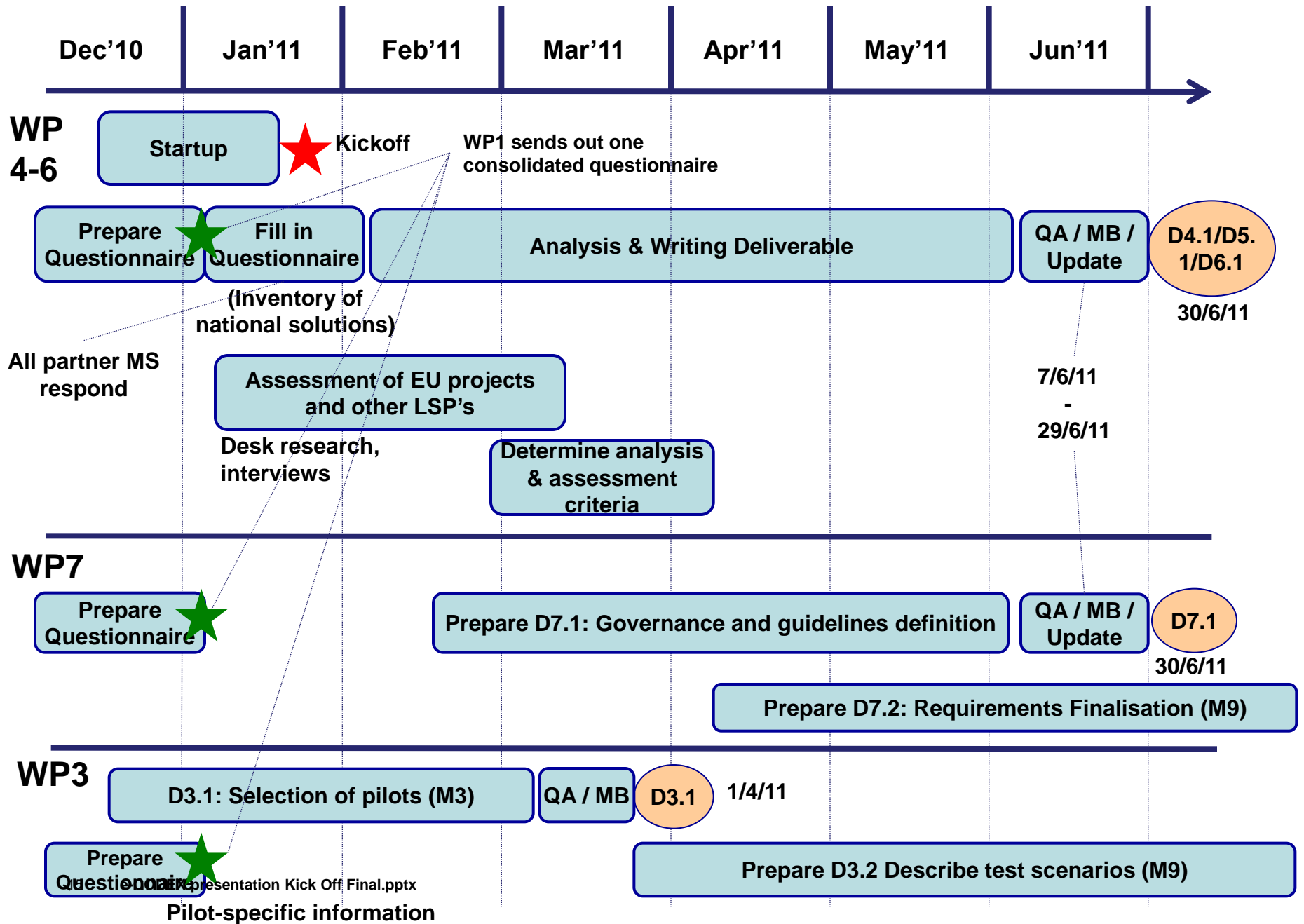
