#### **HOW DOES IT ALL START?**

Seller and Buyer in the UK

Parties elect their national law / Contract

English Notary formalises the transaction

Netpro is the "enabling tool".

# What is the Netpro contract?

- Agreement Conveyancer / Support Provider
- Principal Agent relation formalised
- Defined terms and conditions
- Choice of applicable law / contractual relation
- Art 3 Rome I Regulation (EC/593/2008)



#### How does it work?

- 1. Portal Selection of target country
- 2. Selection of region for required assistance
- 3. Select service provider in that region
- 4. Complete online contract instructions
- 5. Electronic submission of assistance request



#### How does it work?

- 6. Upload information and copy docs
- 7. Services provider sends quotation
- 8. Acceptance of quotation / formalises agreement.
- 9. Funds on account may be required
- 10. All funds made to provider's nominated account



# How long does it take?

Services provider has 15 calendar days.

Temporary Exclusivity

Non-acceptance

Failure to respond

#### PRE- CONTRACT:

Land Registry Title Information
Cadastral registry information
Environmental & Planning Enquiries
Habitation Certificates
Tax ID (NIE)
Translations / explanations



#### What services can be contracted?

#### POST COMPLETION:

Legal notifications

Payment of stamp duty and purchase/ sale taxes

Registration of title / land registry Secure return of documentation.
