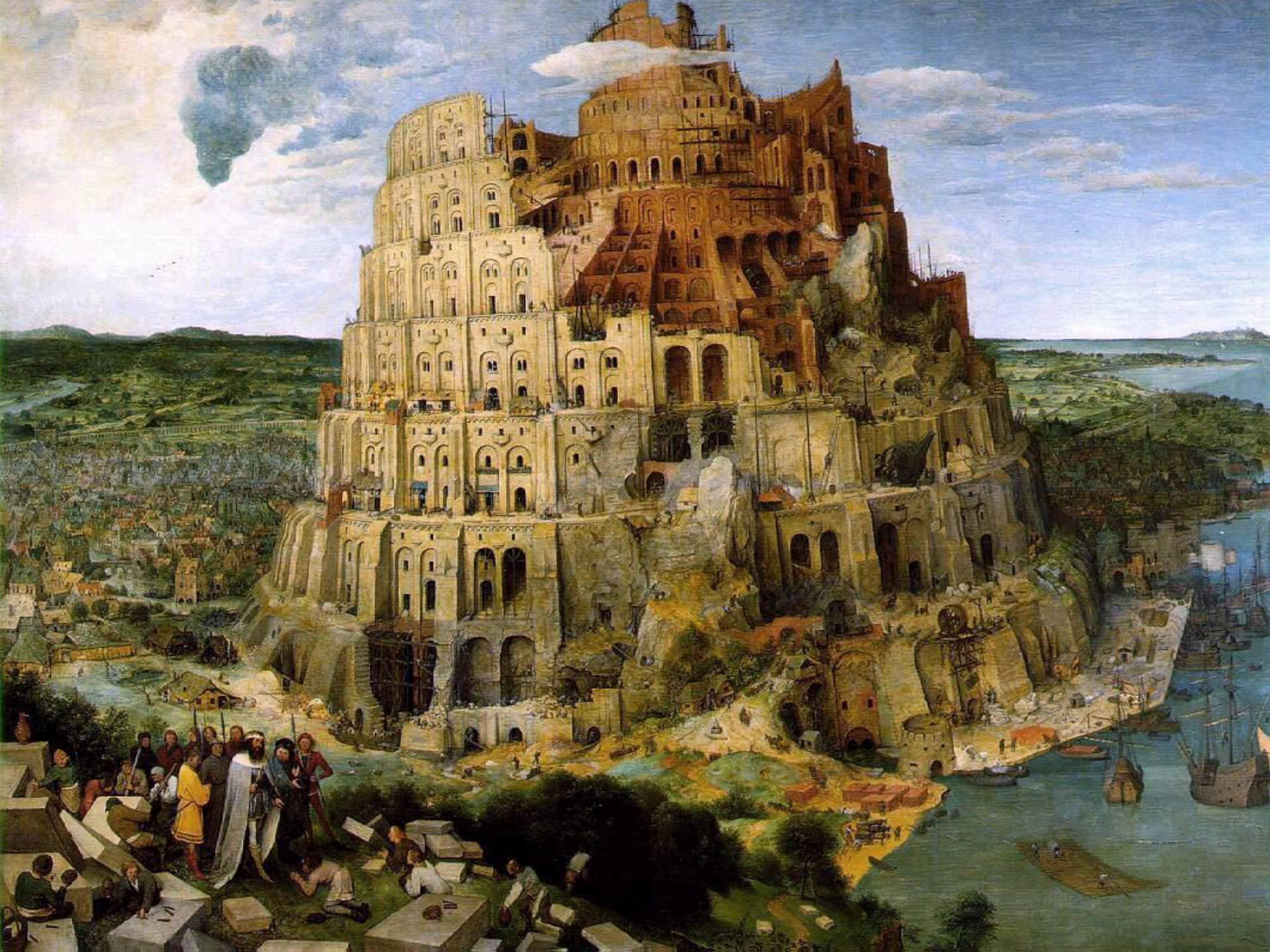

Judicial cooperation

- eJustice Programme 2014 to 2020 (1382/2013)
- Strategy for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth.
- Recital 5: Judicial training is central to building mutual trust and improves cooperation between judicial authorities and practitioners in the various MS.



Judicial cooperation (2)

- Article 4 (1) (b): specific objects:
support and promote judicial training, including language training on *legal terminology*, with a view to fostering a common legal and judicial culture
- Article 6 (1) (c): type of actions:
the further development of the European e-Justice portal
