
Succession register: content

- ➤ Wills and succession contracts;
- ➤ Other information related to succession proceedings:
 - ✓ Initiation of succession proceedings;
 - ✓ Succession certificates, incl. successors;
 - ✓ Management measures (administration).

Succession register: main principles

- > Confidentiality until registration of death
- > Fully electronic procedures:
 - ✓ Registration of information
 - ✓ Access
- ➤ Starting from 2015 under competence of Chamber of Notaries
