Connecting Europe :

The need for Interconnection of Land Registries

- Need for standard means of accessing basic land registry information within the EU
- Cross-border exchange of information
- Differences vs common points



Interconnection of Land Registries:

- Enable legal practitioners to cooperate with colleagues in other EU countries
- Make justice more accessible
- Make cross border justice work



Role of IMOLA

- Common semantic approach model
- Ambitious goal - linking Land Registries of Europe
- Ease of doing business
- Encouraging European countries to work closely together
