Electronically signed contracts

- » nature of the document

» locus regit actum







Regulation Rome I (Regulation EU 593/2008, 17/06)

article 11 – formal validity of contracts and unilateral acts

- » the law which governs it in substance;
- » the law of the country where it is concluded (locus regit actum) or of either of the countries where either of the parties is present at the time of conclusion (a new locus regit actum);
- » the law of the country where either of the parties had his habitual residence at that time.
