- 2. If individuals and business could take advantage of electronic communications with courts.







The consultation also refeers to other competent authorities who communicate with courts

Thus, Land Registries could be included







OUR INSTITUTIONAL ANSWER: GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- I. LR provides information, which in some countries is open and in others restricted
 - Identification
 - Attributes
 - Standard display = ELRD document
 - Understandable = IMOLA







II. Reception and registration of documents

LR are intended to receive judicial documents as provided in different EU instruments

Interconection should also imply this

- Security
- Technological neutrality
- National Law
- Desirable European Platform







III. Electronic documents for electronic circulation

It should comply with technological conditions:

✓ Readable

✓ Able to be processed

and subtantive requirements of authenticity







IV. Certification of foreign documents according to national law

- Qualified or unqualified documents
- Integrity and proper identification
- Maintaining requirements for reliability

V. Electronic Identification

Parties, but also submitter Regulation 910/2014 (IDAS)
