Connecting Europe : The need for Interconnection of Land Registries


- ▶ Need for standard means of accessing basic land registry information within the EU
- ▶ Information only accessible through different national systems
- ▶ Cross-border exchange of information
- ▶ Differences vs common points

- ▶ Ambitious goal - linking Land Registries of Europe
- ▶ Ease of doing business
- ▶ Encouraging European countries to work closely together
