


NEW LAND CREATED BY THE VOLCANO LAVA

At the Spanish LR Geoportal (https://geoportal.registradores.org/) we have created an specific section to consult the land plots or LR Units affected by Cumbre Vieja volcano eruption in La Palma island.



Once we click on the volcano info icon, a brief explanation is displayed at the same panel about how to get LR information of the plots or LR Units affected by the eruption



Explanation of how to get LR information about LR Units affected by the eruption.

The text is the following one:

"If unfortunately you have been affected by the volcano eruption we provide you the telephone number of Santa Cruz de La Palma Land Register office, where you should call to be informed and get a free and immediate certificate of all your properties".



If you have doubts whether your property has been affected or not click on this link and you will be able to navigate over the zone. To get further information right-click on the mouse over the point you desire to be informed and select the option Affected by the eruption? ¿Afectado por la erupción ?"

If you click on the "Information" icon, a viewer is displayed directly zooming in the affected zone of La Palma island.



Affected by the eruption.

The information displayed is the following:

- Layer of volcano lava flow. In red. This cartographic information is provided by the EC COPERNICUS Emergency Management Service.
- Our viewer is daily updated with the data published by this service.

- Cadastral parcels layer. Polygons with black edges. This cartography is provided by the Spanish Cadster.
- LR information layer. Polygons with black edges and coloured in green. This information is obtained from those LR Units where a valid cadastral reference has been entered. In these cases if an inquirement is made over the graphic polygon about the volcano affectation status the Unique LR Unit identifier of the land plot will be shown.
- The PNOA (National Plan on Aerial Orhophotography) orhophotography display is then activated.

The way of consulting is to point over the land plot zooming in the zone of our interest. We then right-click on the land plot and select the option "Affected by the eruption?" pción ¿Afectado por la erupción?

A side panel is displayed with information about the selected land plot.

The different possible outcomes are now explained

1. Outcome depending on the plot situation


If the plot is on the lava flow, that is, inside the red zone drawn on the map, the outcome will show the cadastral reference, the es decir dentro de la zona roja en el mapa, el resultado mostrará la referencia catastral and the land use and will inform the plot is affected by the volcano eruption.

❖ If the plot is at a certain distance from the affected zone, the outcome will show the cadastral reference and land use and will inform that the plot is a certain distance from thelava flow affected zone.

2. Outcome depending on the available data.

❖ If there is a possibly affected construction, besides the beforesaid information, an image of the construction front will be displayed with the text: "a possibly affected construction has been detected".



Affected plot with possibly affected construction.




If the consulted plot is identified with its LR data (those polygons coloured in green on the map), the Unique LR Unit Identifier (CRU) will be shown, whether it is a plot inside or at a certain distance from the affected zone.
