The Board of Directors met on 4th March 2022 in Brussels adopted the following declaration:

“In this tremendously difficult moment that our neighboring country, Ukraine, is going through, ELRA, as a European Association, representing Land Registries in Europe, wishes to express solidarity with the Ukrainian people.

President von der Leyen said that “this is a moment of truth for Europe”, a moment when Europe shows the values for which we stand for, defending the primacy of the rule of law and democracy.
